Wolterbeek Annual Atom Tournament

Tournament Rules

Games (including championship games) will consist of two 10-minute stop-time periods and one 15-minute stop-time period. All games will be maximum 50 minutes running time which includes a 2 minute warm-up. The running clock is turned off during OT.

1. Mercy Rule - 5 goal difference; will apply after the 2nd period. If this occurs, then there will be no stop time on the game clock. When the difference becomes less than 5 goals, stopped time will then be back in effect. Penalties when the Mercy Rule is in affect will be 3 minutes instead of 2 minutes.
2. Tied games will be resolved by sudden-death, stop-time periods as follows:
 - 1st overtime period 5 minutes 4 on 4, plus goalie
 - 2nd overtime period 5 minutes 3 on 3, plus goalie
 - The running clock is turned off during OT
 - All penalties incurred in regular time must carry over into overtime.
 - At no time will a team go below three skaters and one goalie in the event of a penalty the non-penalized team will add one skater and the penalized team will put a player in the penalty box.
 - At the expiration of the penalty, the player will come out of the box and remain on the ice until the first stoppage in play when both teams will revert back to three skaters and one goalie.
 - If the game remains tied at the end of overtime periods, the "Penalty Shot" rule will apply. The coach of each team will select three (3) players to participate in a shoot out against the goaltender of the opposing team. Both teams will shoot simultaneously until all six players have had a chance to shoot.
 - If the game remains tied, the shoot-out will continue in a "sudden death" format. A winner will be chosen when one team scores and the other does not. No player may shoot twice in the shoot-out until all available players have taken a turn.
 - Any player in the penalty box at the end of the second sudden-death period will not be eligible for the shoot-out.
